## **Best Views of the Golden Gate Bridge | Epic Golden Gate**

The story of the Golden Gate Bridge starts with the Golden Gate Strait, the waterway connecting the Pacific Ocean to San Francisco Bay from which the bridge gets its name. The strait is notoriously treacherous, with currents that churn from 4.5 to 7.5 knots, winds that reach up to 60 miles per hour, and a muddy depth of more than 300 feet.
